## CHARTER



### THE FLORIDA CHAPTER

Whereas, D. C. Bailey, Ben Demby, Francis J. Sachse, all residents of the State of Florida, have filed their application in writing with the Associated Police Communication Officers, Incorporated in the Office of the Secretary-Treasurer as required by Article I, Section 3, (Amended) of the Constitution, for authority to organize a Chapter under the name THE FLORIDA CHAPTER, ASSOCIATED POLICE COMMUNICATION OFFICERS, Incorporated, to be located at a place within the State of Florida. The said FLORIDA CHAPTER has in all respects complied with all requirements of the Constitution and By-Laws governing the formation of same.

Now Therefore, I, Ero Erickson, Secretary-Treasurer of the Associated Police Communication Officers, Incorporated, and acting under the direction of Frank W. Walker, President, in virtue and by authority of Article I, Section 3, (Amended) of the Constitution, do hereby certify that said parties, their associates and successors have become a Body, duly organized under the name, THE FLORIDA CHAPTER, ASSOCIATED POLICE COMMUNICATION OFFICERS, Incorporated, located at a place within the State of Florida and shall have all the rights and privileges granted to State or Regional Chapters under the Constitution.
